SUMMARY

Architect and urban planner with a degree With Honours, from the Higher School of Technical Architecture of the Polytechnic University of Madrid (ETSAM-UPM) in 1990 and post-graduate studies at the School of Architecture of Turin, focusing on the renewal of large abandoned industrial infrastructures in the urban context. At King Juan Carlos University of Madrid she specialised in creative territories and cities, and has also received training in different areas linked to contemporary art and culture.

Until 2013 she directed in Madrid, the Architecture, City and Territory section of the Me(c)sa (Marcial Echenique y Cía) urban design and transportation company, whose plans and projects run from urban landscape planning and culture to conceptual positions and development tools.

In 2014 Me(c)sa was absorbed by the company Prointec (Indra Group), where she headed the Urban Development section and later took charge of national and international Executive Business Development; this involved detecting opportunities, setting up strategic alliances and overseeing technical content. She combined these tasks with advice on landscape and urban renewal. At Prointec she helped produce the document on inclusion of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG's) in the company's corporate and business activity and formed part of the joint groups for integration of technology in the city and urban planning activity (smart cities).

Associate professor at ETSAM-UPM from 2000 to 2010, in the Urban and Territorial Planning Department; member of the Cultural Landscape Research Group. She teaches occasionally at the Madrid School of Architecture and the University of Venice (IUAV). Co-director of the workshop on cities for the master's degree in creative economy, 2016 and 2017.

Since 2019 she has worked independently as an architect and urban planner oriented to the public and private sectors. She maintains links to academia, the third sector and the business world. Since 2019 she has been a patron of the *Fundación Cultura en Vena* https://www.culturaenvena.org/equipo/ and an adviser to the Madrid Business Forum (MFE) since 2018.

In 2019 she founded the **urbanAlibi** brand, an office for creative urban design and a laboratory for ideas about the city, open to interdisciplinary collaboration as a methodological tool. **uA** aims to provide responses to the challenges facing contemporary society, framed in the SDGs and the United Nations Urban Agenda, combining rigour in urbanism with making a difference: the integration of culture, art and landscape in urban planning as cross-cutting development and innovation vectors to achieve more humanised, attractive and competitive territories (smart territories).
